Plitvice Lakes These stunning lakes are hemmed in by a thick carpet of forest and the water falling from upper to lower levels creates a series of spectacular waterfalls

Tour to **Pula** and its amphitheatre, coastal town of **Porec** and **Roninj, church of St Euphemia**

Guided tour of **The Revoltella Art Museum** in Trieste. The Revoltella Museum is the civic modern and contemporary art gallery founded in 1872, by Baron Pasquale Revoltella.
